People born in the month of May are either Taurus or Gemini. Taurus covers April 20th – May 20th, whilst Gemini covers 21st – June 20th.May


Taurus, which is an earth sign has pink and green as its colours and is represented by a bull. A Taurus is known to have a practical, grounded, and realistic perspective!


